Trafficking Scouts frequently canvas:

- Parks and schools
- Stores and shopping malls
- Gas stations and transport hubs
- Entertainment venues (all types)
- Apps with communication portals and Social media
- Foreign labor locations
- Parking lots
- Unattended minors & At-risk youth
- Disadvantaged communities



Human Trafficking is forced or coerced servitude for sex or labor.

It is a slavery enterprise that is often **hidden in plain sight**.

Signs that victims may exhibit:

- Evidence of physical abuse
- Branding marks
- Use of code language
- Possession of Fake ID's
- Underage street vendors
- Unaccompanied minors
- Downcast (eye contact avoidance)
- Vague, or evasive conversation
- Noticeable fear that is unspoken
- Obsessive use of multiple digital devices
